1. Personal Letter of Application. Submit a personal letter, no longer than 300 words, with this application. Please do **NOT** put your name anywhere on your personal letter. Personal letters will be evaluated solely on content. Personal letters should include your goals, activities, interests and needs, both in and out

of school. To assist us in reading personal letters, please **TYPE** or **PRINT** clearly.
