I write as a follow-up to our telephone conversation earlier today in which you advised me that the State's contract offer to the two State/Council 82 bargaining units is the same basic raises negotiated with the other State unions for 2008, 2009, 2010, and 2011, except that for 2009 the offer is 0% and that the State is looking for a 5-day payroll lag.

Council 82 rejects this offer, but I want to make it clear that we are always open to continued dialogue and a negotiated settlement.
