

Benefit for Kim Doolittle



Kim Doolittle is a 28 year old woman battling a malignant and aggressive form of cancer. On January 28, 2009, what was initially thought to be a simple muscle strain, was diagnosed as a 5 ½ inch in diameter stage three high grade Sarcoma. In Kim's case, the tumor is located near her lumbar spine; it has since grown 25% and is pushing on her right kidney, stomach, gall bladder and intestines. Kim recently completed 5 ½ weeks of radiation treatment at Roswell Park; the treatment is to prepare her for necessary, major surgery to remove the tumor. It is likely Kim will lose her right kidney and need additional radiation and/or chemotherapy treatments after surgery.

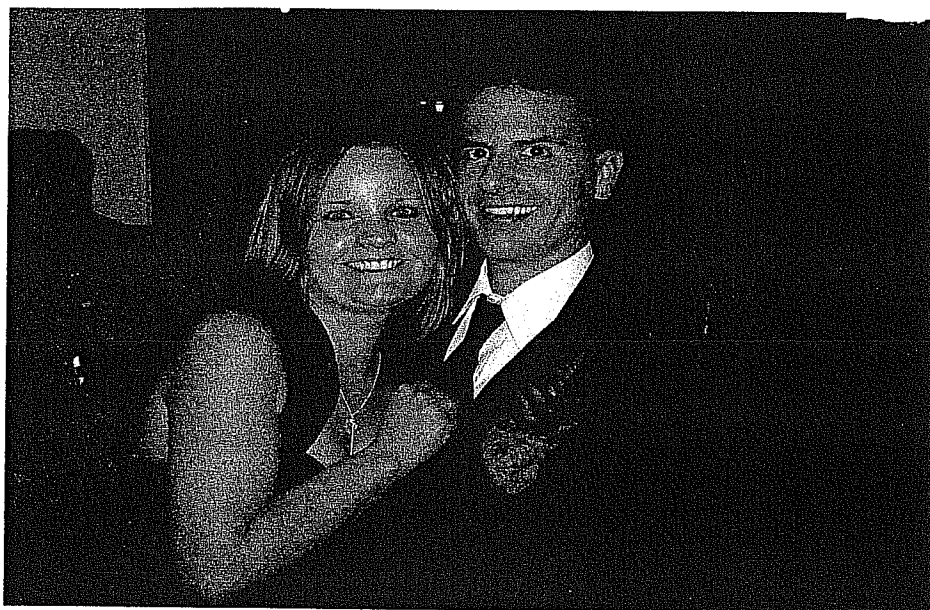
